Tobacco products package coverage and location

Graphic health warnings are required to cover the top 60% of the front and 60% of the back of the package. Overall, 60% of the package space is allocated to health warnings.

Misleading information

Misleading descriptors such as 'light,' 'ultra,' and 'mild,' graphics, numbers, and figures for emissions yields (including tar, nicotine, and carbon monoxide) are prohibited from appearing on packages.

Constituents and emissions information

A single message is required to display qualitative (descriptive) constituents and emissions information on one side panel.

Special notes

The law also requires graphic health warnings to appear on all six sides of each carton, occupying 60% of each side. Each carton must depict at least three different health warnings.

Rotation schedule, history, language, and help for smoking cessation

Jamaica has produced two rounds of graphic health warning labels:



Warnings within each Round are required to be rotated for a period of 12 months. Warning texts must be in English, the principal language of the country.





